Dear Families,

In the High School at AIS, we follow a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) Program that requires the use of a laptop. All students will use laptops to write when researching, creating, and documenting their schoolwork.

Technology in classes is driven by learning and students are expected to use their devices only for educational purposes. Below you will find the technology guidelines as well as advice on how to support them in practicing some of the skills they will need in High School. ***Please note that student cell phones are not an acceptable replacement or substitute for a laptop.***

### Internet Access

Internet access is important as it allows your child to share work with their teacher, classmates, families, do research, and more. Our clean filtered internet enables safe access to approved content when students are connected to school wi-fi.

Classroom teachers will assist students with connecting to the wi-fi once payment has been made. Students who were previously connected using the same device will automatically reconnect at the beginning of the school year.

Personal cell phone hotspots will not be permitted at any time.

### Software, Email and Passwords

Your child will need to access **Microsoft Office 365** with their school email account.
