Internet Access and Setup	
<p>Internet access is important as it allows your child to share work with their teacher, classmates, families, do research, and more. Our clean filtered internet enables safe access to approved content when students are connected to school wi-fi.</p> <p>Homeroom teachers will assist students with connecting to the wi-fi. Students who were previously connected using the same device will automatically reconnect at the beginning of the school year.</p> <p>Personal cell phone hotspots and personal internet routers <u>will not</u> be permitted at any time.</p>	
Software and Passwords	
<p>Seesaw is the main app for learning journals and communicating student learning home.</p> <p>Your child will also learn with a variety of apps.
